

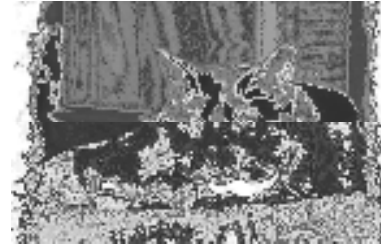


Animal Rescue League of NH Presents:
