Three-year old Calvin came to us because his family could not afford to maintain his daily care. On the day of Calvin's arrival we realized that this boy would require a lot of TLC.

Severely underweight at a mere sixty-six pounds he needed proper nutrition right away. He had an injury to his tail, and he suffered from ruptured ear drums in both ears that required surgery. He was also in need of daily ear cleaning and medication in addition to an internal antibiotic.

Since December 21st Calvin has been neutered, had a partial tail amputation (from his constant wagging he continuously caused injury to his already-fragile tail, rupturing it beyond repair), and he has gained an amazing 20½ pounds!

Calvin is very friendly, and now that he is feeling better he finally is ready for his new family to find him.

Thank you so much for making the lives of Roxi, Rubi and Calvin so much better and giving them a second chance.
