








February is spay and neuter awareness month!


By spaying or neutering your pet, you help give shelter pets an increased chance of finding a home and help decrease the number of pets entering shelters each year.




Even though cats cannot talk, they can still communicate with us without using words. Draw a line from the description of how the animal feels to the picture of that animal.


CATS

Tasty Tuna Cat Treats are a crispy, healthy homemade snack for the favorite felines in your family!


- 6 ounces undrained tuna
- 1 cup flour
- 1 cup cornmeal
- 1 egg
- 2 T water



- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
- Place all ingredients into mixing bowl, stir well until soft dough forms.
- 3. Let dough rest for 10 minutes.
- 4. Cover large surface with cornmeal and roll dough out until ¼ inch thick.
- Use either a small cookie cutter or knife to cut into shapes.
- 6. Place on parchment paper lined cookie sheet and bake for 15-20 minutes.
- 7. Let cool and serve to kitty!











