## December is National Cat Lover Month!

In honor of Cat Lover Month, you knead to take a meow-ment to read these paw-some facts!



- 1. Cats Can Jump Up to Six Times Their Body Length. Most cats can jump up to six times their body length, partly due to their strong legs and flexible spine.
- 2. Cats Have an Extra Organ that Helps Them Taste. They have an extra organ in their mouth called the Jacobson's organ, or vomeronasal organ, located inside the nasal cavity and the roof of the mouth, which helps them taste and smell things that are not detected by the normal taste buds.
- 3. Cats Can't Taste Sweetness. This is because cats are carnivores and thrive on a meat-based diet, and they are not biologically able to taste sugar.
- 4. A Group of Cats is Called a Clowder. Just like a group of dogs is called a pack, a group of cats is called a clowder.
- 5. **Cats Have an Amazing Sense of Balance.** Cats are famous for their amazing sense of balance, and have what's called a righting reflex and and a very flexible spine, which allows them to twist their bodies in mid-air to land on their feet.

## Easy Cat Enrichment DIY Activities

#### CAT TOY WANDS

Materials: Wooden Dowel Bells Fabric scraps – ribbons, clean shoelaces, yarn, etc. Scissors Optional: Baker's Twine or similar to cover the dowel and Fabric Glue



Instructions:

 To make your wand look "irresistible", begin by wrapping the plain wooden dowel with Baker's Twine. When you finish wrapping the dowel, leave an excess amount (10-12 inches) so that you can tie your fabric scraps to the end. Use a small amount of fabric glue to secure the twine to the dowel, so that it doesn't unravel. OR
Drill a small hole in one end of the wooden dowel and thread a long piece of the Baker's Twine through the hole. Tie the twine in a knot to secure it to the wooden dowel.

3. Take all of your fabric scraps and tie them to the end of the Baker's Twine.

4. Select different scraps of fabric and tie on the jingle bells for added fun!

#### CAT PUZZLES

Materials:

Toilet paper or paper towel rolls Empty square or rectangle tissue box or a shoe box Hot glue gun Scissors




Instructions:

1. If using a tissue box, cut off the top so that the box is open.

2. Cut the tubes to the same length as the height of the box if needed.

3. Place the tubes in the box, gluing each one in place as you go. Continue until the box is filled snugly with the tubes.

4. Deliver to the shelter, and we will fill the tubes with treats to keep our cats busy and entertained!










## Our Book of the Month!
